NEIGHBORS HELPING NEIGHBORS

“I’m Not Afraid Anymore”: A Survivor’s Story of Strength, Rural Resilience, and Community Care by Stacy Sunvission, LHC Grateful Patient

A year and a half ago, everything changed. I landed in the emergency room at Livingston HealthCare, hemorrhaging badly. I didn’t realize it then, but it was ovarian cancer. My blood count was terrifyingly low, 2.9, when it should have been between 13 and 15. I needed seven blood transfusions and five iron infusions to stabilize.

I spent one night in the ICU and five days in the hospital. The care I received was excellent; the nurses listened, and the doctors acted quickly. Then came the diagnosis: stage 4 ovarian cancer. That moment hits you like a wall. Nobody wants to hear it. But I decided - right then- I was going to be positive. I wasn’t going to look back. I was going to fight.

Dr. Stone, outreach Billings Clinic Oncology, helped get things moving quickly - my first PET scan, the initial treatment plan. Then Dr. Fleming came on board and has been incredible. The whole Livingston HealthCare infusion team is dialed in. And the nurses here? They’re my people. Sunny “Funny Sunny.” Mel, Val, Mary. We’re on a first-name basis. They make me feel like I’m not just a patient, but part of a family.

I refused to go to Billings for treatment. Why would I travel two hours - cross a mountain pass in the winter - when I can get world-class care 10 minutes from home? That’s not being hard-headed, that’s being smart. That’s understanding what it means to live in rural Montana.



I’ve changed how I live. No pop in over a year and a half. I watch my sugar. I walk with my Bernese Mountain dog, my “service dog.” I ride my stationary bike regularly. I’ve learned so much through this process - I joke that I could almost be a doctor now.

Dr. Pihl keeps tabs on my thyroid and blood pressure - she’s helped me feel better than I have in years, even while on chemo. Before, I couldn’t walk to the car without losing my breath. Now, I walk daily. I feel stronger.

It wasn’t always like this. I used to be afraid - terrified to go to the doctor. I avoided care out of fear of what I might find. But when I started bleeding so badly, I had no choice. My family said, “You’re going.” And thank God they did. Now, I’m not afraid anymore. Cancer is scary, but it doesn’t define me. I took control. I stayed positive. And that mindset - along with an incredible care team and a lot of love - got me through.

DEBBIE ERDMAN-LEE FREEMAN



Deborah Erdman, MD (1950–2022) was a deeply respected and beloved physician, philanthropist, and friend to the Livingston community. Over her seventeen years at Livingston HealthCare, Dr. Erdman helped bring countless lives into the world as an OB/GYN, leaving an indelible mark on generations of families. She had a thoughtful commitment to medical ethics, serving as Chair of the Ethics Committee at LHC’s Park Clinic. In 2015, she and David Stanley co-chaired the successful \$10 million New Hospital Campaign, helping to make the vision of our current facility a reality. We are profoundly grateful for their leadership - and for the dedication of so many others who joined in that effort. Sadly, Dr. Erdman passed away in December 2022, but her legacy lives on through the kindness, friendship, and philanthropy she shared with countless individuals and organizations in our community. Her compassion, generosity, and unwavering care for patients, colleagues, and the broader community continue to shine, leaving a lasting impact in the hearts of all those she touched.

Lee A. Freeman, Jr. is a distinguished trial lawyer and former lead counsel in major complex commercial cases nationwide. Renowned for his expertise in antitrust law, he has also litigated cases involving securities and commodities, public utility regulation, ERISA, and accounting issues. He served as an arbitrator with FedArb, focusing on similarly complex matters. A magna cum laude graduate of both Harvard College and Harvard Law School, Lee clerked for U.S. Supreme Court Justice Tom C. Clark and later served as an Assistant U.S. Attorney in Washington, D.C. He was a partner at Freeman, Freeman & Salzman in Chicago and acted as Special Assistant Attorney General for antitrust litigation on behalf of multiple states. Lee is also a committed philanthropist, generously supporting numerous causes - including many in Montana - through both his time and resources.

Honoring Dr. Marcia Bull McCrum & A. Bliss McCrum Jr.

Dr. Marcia Bull McCrum and her late husband, Bliss McCrum, have left a lasting mark on Park County through their generosity, vision, and service. Marcia earned her medical degree from Columbia University after graduating summa cum laude from Mount Holyoke College. She served as Chief of Cardiology at Stamford Hospital for 30 years before retiring to Paradise Valley in 2004 with Bliss. Arlington Bliss McCrum, Jr. graduated from Princeton in 1954 and served as a U.S. Army Lieutenant in Germany before earning his MBA from Wharton in 1958. He began his finance career at Dominick and Dominick and later co-founded Euclid Partners, a venture capital firm in New York City. In 1981, he married cardiologist Dr. Marcia B. Bull; Bliss brought six children to the marriage, and Marcia brought three. They settled in New Canaan, Connecticut. There, Bliss co-founded the Horizons program for underserved students and the New Canaan Inn for seniors, serving on both boards and supporting numerous local nonprofits. He lived by the motto: “Learn, earn, and return.” Together, the McCrums have supported numerous local causes, including Livingston HealthCare, the Food Resource Center, the Shane Center, the Park County Community Foundation, and local education initiatives. Marcia also served on the Livingston HealthCare Foundation Board from 2019 to 2021 and was a member of the Capital Campaign Committee to help raise \$10 million for the ‘new hospital.’ She remains a devoted supporter. We are proud to honor Dr. Marcia Bull McCrum and her late husband, Bliss, for their extraordinary contributions to our healthcare system and community.
